- 1. FOR INTENDED INCREASE IN TUITION, seventy percent (70%) of the incremental proceeds of tuition fee increases shall be used for the benefit of teaching and non-teaching personnel and other staff, except those who are principal stockholders of the HEI, including such increases as may have been provided for in the Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA), if any, existing or in force at the time when Republic Act (RA) 6728 took effect.
- 2. Twenty percent (20%) of the proceeds derived from tuition fee increases shall be used for but not limited to the following capital expenditures:
  - Acquisition of smart TVs in classrooms
  - Acquisition of service laptops
  - Acquisition of CCTV within school premises
  - Internet bandwidth upgrade
  - Upgrade of electronic enrollment system
  - Upgrade of Legal Aid Office equipment and facility
  - Repair and acquisition of air-conditioning units
  - Repainting and refurbishing of walls and ceilings
  - Upgrade of school sound system and equipment
  - Repair and recondition of elevator units

- 1) There was no increase in the fees of COL since AY 2016-2017
- 2) As agreed with the College, to increase **Library Fee** by 10% for the procurement of more
- 3) The increase of P500 of **Technology Fee** is for the improvement of the ICTD facilities in aid to student learning.
- 4) The **Legal Aid Clinic Fee** and **Student Activity Fee** increases of P500 each is requested by the College to cover various student activities and events during the year.
- 5) The increase of P100 of **Bar Operation Fee** is requested by the College to cover activites related to bar exams.
- 6) The charge for **Insurance Fee** depends on the premium set by the Insurance Agency; his is assessed once every Academic Year.
- 7) Increases for Law Council Fee and Journal Publication Fee may depend on the request of the student body. However, for presentation purposes, a 5% increase across the board was effected.
